ABOUT TYAX LODGE & HELISKIING

Tyax Lodge is a remote full-service wilderness lodge, located in the beautiful South Chilcotin mountains of BC, a 5-6 hour drive north of Vancouver. We operate from January to April for heliskiing adventures exclusively, and from May to October we host mountain biking enthusiasts, nature lovers, weddings and other events.

THE AREA

The Bridge River Valley is popular amongst nature and adventure lovers. The nearby tows of Gold Bridge and Bralorne have populations of just a few hundred people, but back in the 1800's the valley was very popular for gold mining, leaving the area with endless wilderness systems of hiking and biking trails, and many lakes to explore.
